Hello Mr. Ahmed,

The Town of Erin has not fulfilled its commitment to issue an Addendum to the ESR for the Erin Wastewater Treatment Plant (Project), as they clearly committed to in their final Environmental Study Report that was approved by Minister Jeff Yurek. The Coalition for the West Credit River is attaching a letter to that effect which was sent to Minister Piccini on 23 July 2021, and explains our position in detail. In hindsight we realized it should have been copied to you for your information.

In our opinion the Town of Erin is out of compliance with their Project as approved by the Minister, with the provisions of the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment, and the *Environmental Assessment Act*. Until such time as the Town issues an Addendum to the ESR, as well as other additional commitments, and provides a 30 day public consultation period, the Environmental Compliance Approval should not be issued for the Project.
