Application for Investigation into allegations of contraventions of section 38 of the EAA by the Corporation of the Town of Erin

The purpose of this letter is to confirm that the Ministry of Environment, Conservation and Parks received your Application for Investigation on August 10, 2021.

The *Environmental Bill of Rights, 1993* sets out the process and timelines for responding to applications for investigation. The Ministry will review the application and if it is determined that an investigation is required, the results of the investigation will be reported to you within 120 days, by **December 8, 2021**.

If the ministry requires additional time to complete the investigation, you will be notified. You will receive notice of the final outcome within 30 days of the completion of the investigation.

If it is determined that an investigation is not required, you will be notified within 60 days, by **October 11, 2021**
