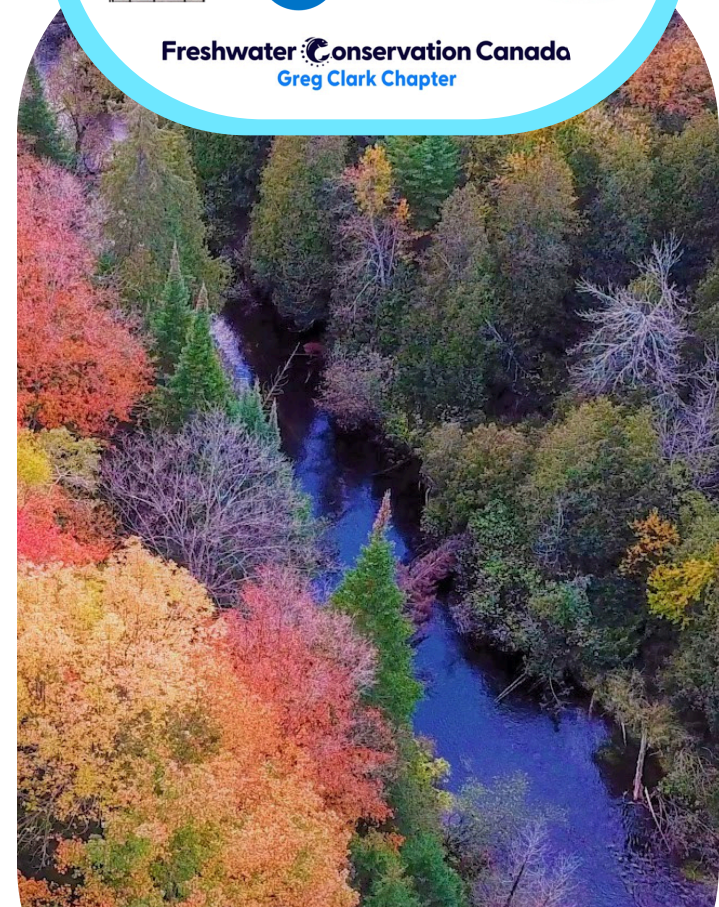

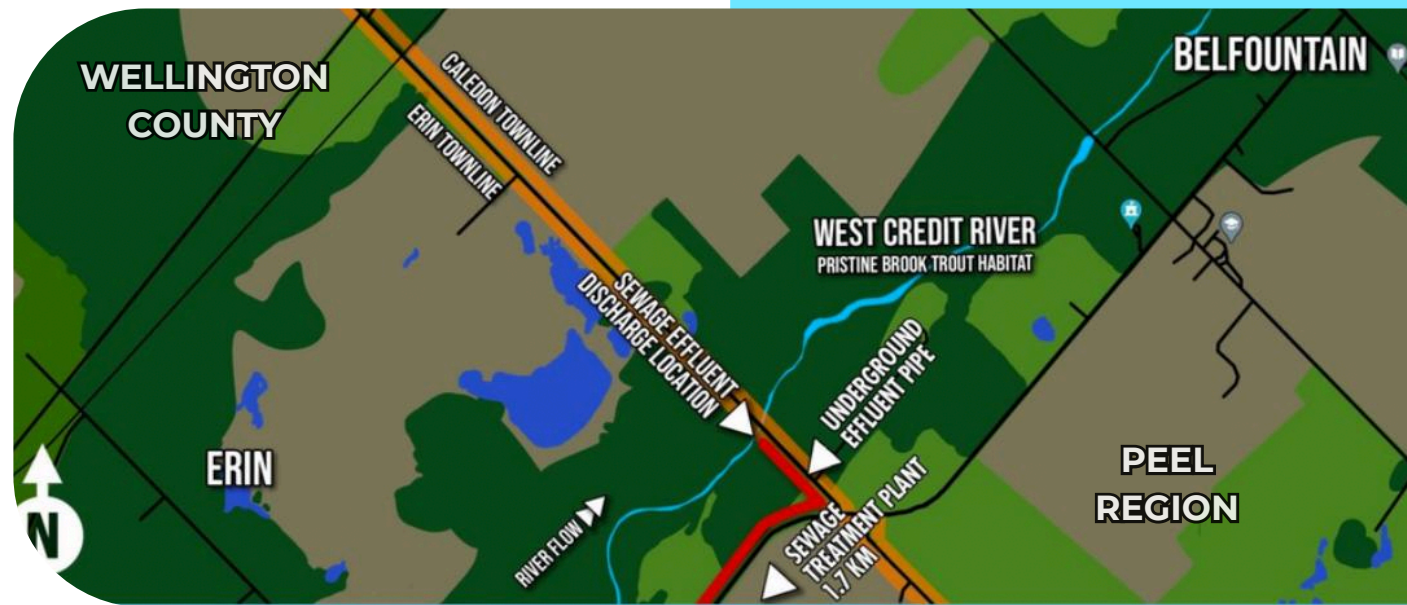

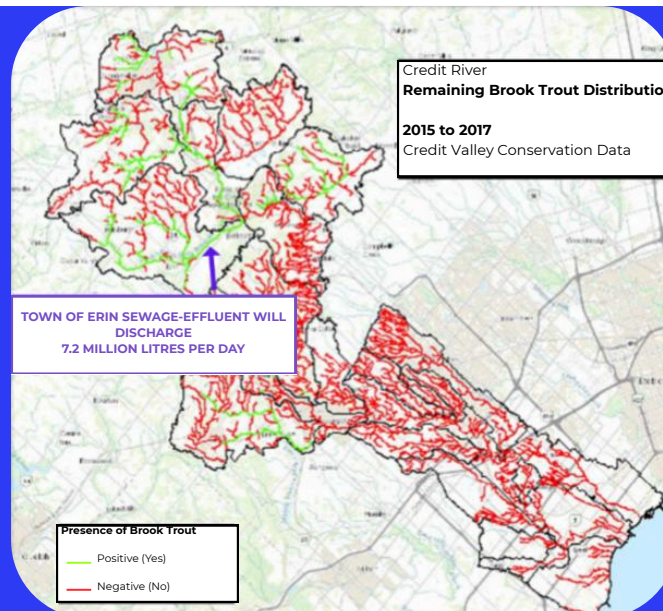

BROOK TROUT AT RISK

The West Credit River has one of the few remaining self-sustaining native Brook Trout populations in southern Ontario. The health and Survival of this thriving population of Brook Trout will be placed at risk as a result of sewage effluent discharged from the Town of Erin Wastewater Treatment Plant. They are a highly sensitive Coldwater species, and their survival relies on stream temperatures no greater than 19 °C for any sustained period.

EFFLUENT DISCHARGE LOCATION

The **Coalition for the West Credit River** is a community of organizations collaboratively involved with issues surrounding the Town of Erin Sewage Plant and the health of the West Credit River. We work to ensure the Town of Erin implements an effective and reliable cooling system to protect this important Brook Trout population.
